ACT is Brighton's premier Drama School training adults for a career in the Acting Profession since 1997. All classes are evenings and weekends, enabling students to undertake Actor Training whilst maintaining their domestic and financial commitments. ACT attracts students of all ages and walks of life and enables people to realistically achieve their ambition of a career in the performing arts.

All our tutors are highly experienced, professional actors and directors who bring contemporary professional practice to their teaching.

ACT graduates are to be found working on National and European tours, on Netflix, Prime, BBC, ITV, and Ch4, Radio, Major and Independent Films, TIE tours, Commercials and Corporate Work.

Our ethos is to provide access to professional, vocational Actor Training for talented individuals unable to follow traditional routes into the acting profession.

ACT COURSES

DIPLOMA IN ACTING ATCL (2 YEAR)

The Diploma is open to students over 18 and there is no upper age limit. The Diploma is a demanding and intensive training course offering a comprehensive actor training. Prospective students must have talent, self belief, motivation, commitment, dedication, self discipline and a generosity of spirit. In return, ACT will provide an inspiring, nurturing, safe and supportive environment and has an absolute commitment to guiding each student to discover and develop their individual and unique talents and skills to the fullest possible extent.

The Diploma runs for six terms over 2 years, 72 weeks in all. Students are required to attend Monday to Thursday evening and Sunday daytime. Course commences September 2025.

Entry via The Two Week Workshop or by Audition.

ONE YEAR FOUNDATION IN ACTING (1 Year)

This course offers a 1 Year part-time training in core acting skills and runs for three terms of 12 continuous weeks.

Foundation aims to equip students who wish to pursue actor training at Diploma level, but who lack the necessary experience, with the fundamental tools for progression. It also suits those students who wish to broaden their knowledge and practical skills in acting and drama but who do not necessarily wish to pursue a professional career.

Runs Sunday daytime and Monday evening. Entry via The Two Week Workshop or by Audition.

AN INTRODUCTION TO PLAYWRITING

The course offers an introduction to some of the skills and techniques needed to write for theatre, as well as insights into the new writing industry in the UK and the process of moving a play from the page to the stage. Over the duration of the course, students will learn how good plays are constructed through exercises and discussions.

The course culminates in two workshop sessions with actors and a script in hand performance of the students work in front of an audience
